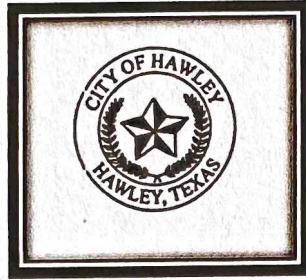

New Business:

A. Mayor Richardson presented Will Womack's resignation from council with Mayor ProTem making a motion to accept the resignation and Councilman Newman providing the second, all approved, and the motion passed.
