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MINUTES FOR THE JUNE 13, 2003 HAWLEY CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting was called to order by Jason Dokey, Mayor Pro Tem at 7:08 pm.

Daniel provided the opening prayer and Jason Dokey led the Pledge of Allegiance.

After reviewing the May 19, 2003, minutes Daniel made the motion to approve the minutes as read and Tisha provided the second. All approved. After reviewing the May 15, Special Meeting minutes, Tisha made the motion to approve the minutes as read and David provided the second. Motions passed.

There were no presentations from the public.

GENERAL PUBLIC PRESENTATION- no public presentation

NEW BUSINESS: Discuss and act on (if required)

- a. Hawley Property Owner – Kevin Frantum, to discuss his property located inside the city limits. Only a small portion of his land is in the city limits. He wishes to secede from the city limits. This issue was tabled for further consideration upon researching the proper procedure. Tisha made a motion to table the issue for further information, Daniel provided the second and the motion carried.
- b. TML 2023 Conference October 4-6, 2023, at the Kay Bailey Hutchison Center in Dallas. Registration begins July 11, 2023, at 10 am. Upon discussion, it was decided that anyone

that can benefit from the convention should go. Tisha made the motion for the above, Daniel provided the second. All approved and the motion carried.

- c. Life Insurance for part time employees if TML will provide the coverage. This issue was tabled for the next council meeting. Tisha made the motion to table the issue and Daniel provided the second. All approved and the motion carried.
- d. Tornado and emergency siren for the city. This issue was tabled until more information can be obtained. Daniel made the motion to table the issue, Tisha seconded. All agreed. The motion was tabled. Old Business: Discuss and act on (if required)

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- a. Hiring Jonathan Bushee to control the feral cat population inside the city. Mr. Bushee reported on his protocol which is a no kill rule. The cats are neutered and relocated. This issue was tabled until it could be placed for a time in the media. Tisha made the motion to table the decision, Daniel provided the second. All agreed, the issue will be tabled.
- b. Ambulance service – upon discussion, it was decided for this to be tabled for further information. Tisha made a motion to table; Daniel provided the second. All approved, the motion carried.
- c. Installing a counter for city hall – After discussion, the Judge stated that the funds would be provided by the security fund. The limit will be \$1200.00. Tisha made a motion for the counter to be built, Daniel provided the second. All approved, motion carried.
- d. Permits for food trucks operating inside the city limits – after discussion it was decided that an ordinance would need to be written. The decision was tabled until that can be done. Daniel made the motion to table the decision, Tisha provided the second. All agreed, motion carried.

Reports: Discuss and act on (if required)

- a. Hawley EDC Report – no report provided.
- b. Administration Report- The administration report was given by Regina Thompson, City Secretary and Court Clerk. She reports on the cost of Central Square at \$100 per month. Also discussed areas that needed to be mowed and sprayed. Daniel made the motion to approve the report, Tisha seconded, all approved, motion carried.
- c. Municipal Court Report – This report was presented by Judge Turner. He reports there were 256 cases and 1 warrant. Tisha made the motion to approve the report, Daniel seconded, all approved and the motion carried.

- d. **Police Report-** report provided by Chief Wilson. He reports there were 49 call which is way down from the month before. Chris will be out working in the community more since school is out for the summer. He states Kaizer, canine officer is feeling much better and is back to work. Tisha made the motion to accept the report, Daniel seconded, all approved and the motion passed.
- e. **Street Report –** No street report was provided.
- f. **Pay Bills –** Motion was made by Tisha to pay the bills; Daniel provided the second. All agreed and the motion passed. The bills will be paid.

Closing Comments and Adjourn:

No Closing Comments were heard.

Tisha made the motion to adjourn, and Daniel provided the second. All agreed and the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:59 pm.
